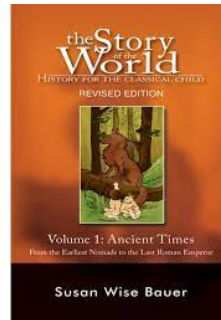


## Cycle 1 Additional Resources

### History:

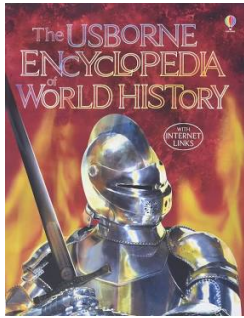
#### *Story of the World, Volume 1- Ancient Times*

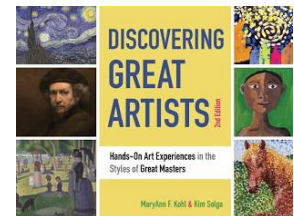


*Discovering Great Artists*
